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Welcome

Welcome, and thank you for choosing Mr James Maths Tuition to help with your studies. Mr James Maths Tuition currently offers both face-to-face and online tuition; allowing you as the student to do what is best for you, with the support from flexible tutors. I hope that you find this guide useful, and that it answers all your questions.

I have over 7 years teaching experience in mathematics, both as a secondary school teacher of mathematics, and personal tutor. Signing up and your first session

Signing Up:

- Online registration form
- Allocation of a tutor
- Arrange a date to conduct assessment

First Session:

- Assessment and putting together a personal learning plan

Plan of Action:

- Estimate of the hours which are needed
- Personalised learning plan
- Online teams account set up (Your tutor will talk you through setting up your account to ensure that you are able to get the most out of what is provided). Students will need to ensure that they are able to download the app on their mobile phone, tablet, computer or laptop in order to be able to access all of the services.

If you opt for online tuition, Microsoft Teams will allow for screen sharing and file sharing as well as a chat function.

Face to face and online tuition

Mr James Maths Tuition offer both online and face to face tuition sessions. If a face to face session has been booked, and the student would like an online session one week instead, they will need to provide their tutor with at least 24 hours notice so that this can be changed, and vice versa.

Face to Face sessions will take place at the students registered address, or a mutually convenient place for both the student and the tutor. (This would need to be agreed in advance of the session taking place). If the student is under 16 years of age, a parent would need to be present during the session.

Online sessions require the use of a device which is compatible with Microsoft Teams. Although students tend to prefer to use their mobile phone, a laptop or table would be more convenient for the sessions due to the need for screen sharing. In addition to this, students will also need access to a webcam and microphone to all for communication to take place during the session. **Sessions will only be conducted using the students registered Teams account.**

Locations covered

At Mr James Maths Tuition we cover the whole of Lincolnshire, and we like to be as flexible as possible and be able to offer both Online and Face to Face sessions, however, due to the travel time taken and cost to get to different areas of the county, there are minimum bulk sessions which will need to be booked in advance for tutors to attend specific areas; please see these distances below. All travel start points will begin from Boston town centre and will be calculated from PE21 6EH and will be calculated to your home address.

25-30 miles	100 hours



There are discounts which are offered for all bookings which have been booked in bulk and paid for in advance.

Please note that the prices for face to face sessions are different to the prices for online sessions.

Upon registration, your tutor will confirm which of the above categories your booking will come under.





Bookings and Policies

- Bookings need to be made in accordance with the Bookings Policy.
- Mr James Maths Tuition is fully complaint with all GDPR processes and further information on how we store your data can be found in the privacy policy.

It will need to be made clear at the time of booking whether this is a face to face, or online session, please note that in order to change this session, a minimum of 24 hours will need to be given to your tutor for this change to take effect. Once a booking has been changed, you will receive an email and text message confirmation of the changes.

Please note that failure to provide 24 hours notice of cancellation of a session will render you liable for the charge of the session, if you pay for your sessions up front, the duration of the session will be deducted from your account.

Communications

We use a range of different communication methods including social media, text message, email, telephone, and WhatsApp. Any of these contact methods can be used to contact regarding general enquiries or bookings. However, to contact your tutor directly, you would need to use their contact details which will be issued at the time of registration.

Please note: There will be times where we need to contact both students and parents, this will be done using the methods listed above.

Equipment

To ensure that students are fully equipped, we recommend that they have the following equipment:

(*Please note that the older model has now been discontinued and is no longer used*).

- Pencil

- Notepad (It is recommended that you use the same notepad each week to ensure consistency and to ensure that all of your notes are in one place!)

Resources

There are different resources which can be used as part of the session. These usually include PowerPoints, worksheets, and exam practice papers. These can come in different forms, and the students will be issued with an electronic copy of all the resources which are used in the session. These resources will be uploaded to the students Microsoft Teams account.

Please note that under no circumstances, should these resources be shared with other people.

Examinations

As a student of Mr James Maths Tuition, there is also the option to sit either the GCSE or Functional Skills Examinations. Mr James Maths Tuition is not an examination centre, however, we do work with centres in which these can be sat.

In order to be booked in for the examinations, there will be a £60.00 administration fee in addition to the centre fees, this administration fee is non-refundable.

There are several points in the year where the Functional Skills examinations can be sat, however, there are only two opportunities in the year where the GCSE can be sat. The summer series May/June which is the main sitting and the November sitting is for re sits only.

We require 6 months notice to arrange GCSE Examinations.

Identification and security clearance

Your tutor will have a photographic identification card which will identify them as a tutor of Mr James Maths Tuition.
